Our response: Am I willing to be identified as a follower of Christ even when it will cost me? (job, raise, being included, friends, a more difficult path)

Our faith will make this possible!

_____ - because of Christ! Faith enables us to put God above earthly treasures because we are living for Him and eternal rewards.

Our response: How real to you are your future rewards in Christ? A stronger faith makes this possible!

_____ - took action and persevered because his faith made the invisible God visible. God was real to him more than a mere concept.

Our response: Ask yourself how real is God to you? The more real He is the more He will influence your day to day life and decisions you make.

_____ - Passover. He believed in God's provision and obeyed.

Our response: To believe in God's provision! Jesus is the savior. In Him we find our identity and purpose in life and have a forever relationship with Him.

Our faith in God and His word gives us the power to act because it gives us the correct and true perspective in life.
