

Acts 2:43-47, Jesus Followers, Part 3

Sermon Outline:

1. Jesus followers are devoted to reverence, 43
2. Jesus followers are devoted to sharing, 44-47a
3. Jesus followers are devoted to dependence, 47b

Discussion:

1. What stood out, challenged, comforted, etc. from this Sunday's teaching?
2. As we grasp the "wonder" of our salvation in Christ, it produces reverence for God in us (i.e. "the fear of the Lord"). How have you seen this to be true in your life? Please share.
3. Share a time when a Christian shared something meaningful with you, whether that was a listening ear, a timely word, a meal, a shoulder to cry on, finances, etc.
4. What are the dangers of depending on the practices of the business world *rather than God* to bring growth and transformation in a church?
5. What are some ways we can "numb" and tune out our desperate need to depend on God?
6. What's one way you can begin to express greater dependence on the Lord this week?
