### **Sermon Outline:**

### **Discussion:**

5. C.S. Lewis writes, "...men spontaneously praise whatever they value...I think we delight to praise what we enjoy because the praise not merely expresses but completes the enjoyment; it is its appointed consummation." Do you agree with him? Why or why not?
6. What are the dangers of anti-intellectualism to our faith? On the other hand, what are the dangers of *over-intellectualizing* our faith? How do we find the right balance?
