

## Acts 3:11-26, Sharing the Gospel

### Sermon Outline:

Sharing the gospel includes...

1. Boasting, 11-13, 16
2. Confrontation, 14-15, 17
3. Fulfillment, 18, 21-24
4. Repentance, 19-20, 25-26

### Discussion:

1. What stood out, challenged or comforted you from this Sunday's teaching?
2. Why can confronting someone with their sin and the need for a Savior be so difficult, so countercultural?
3. D.T. Niles said, "Christianity is just one beggar, telling another beggar where he found some bread." How does this concept influence the way we share the gospel with others?
4. What are the dangers of *not* viewing Jesus as the fulfillment of the story of Scripture? *(For example: the bible can be reduced into just a moral rule book that we follow.)*
5. Peter refers to four benefits of repentance offered to those we share the gospel with: Justification, Forgiveness, Refreshment and Christ's Return. Which one of these particularly blessed you? Why?

  - c. and praying for boldness to share when you ought to
